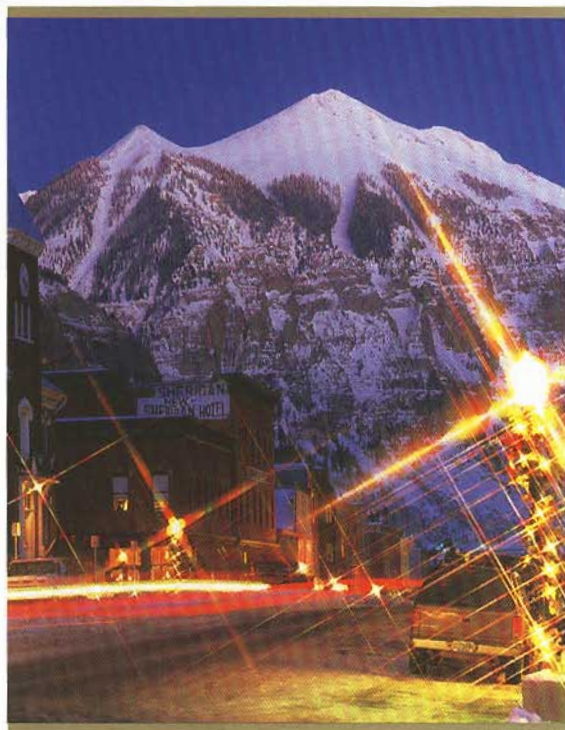

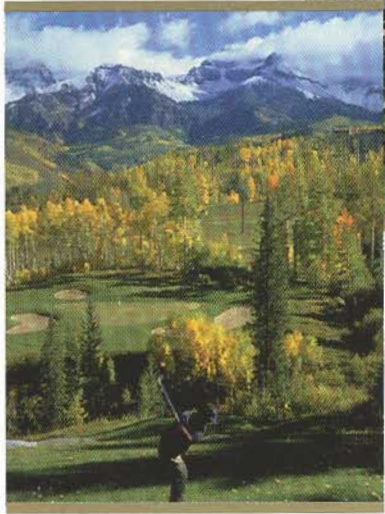

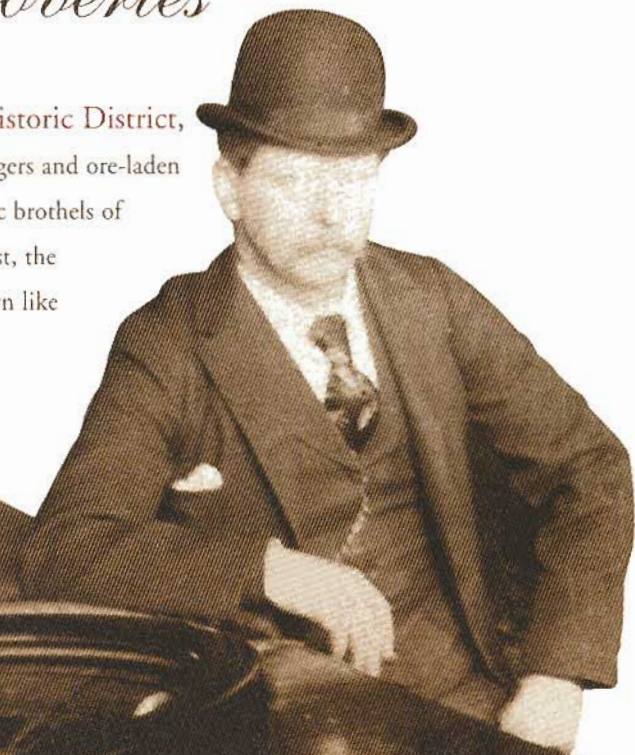

BREAK-OUT TO TOWN

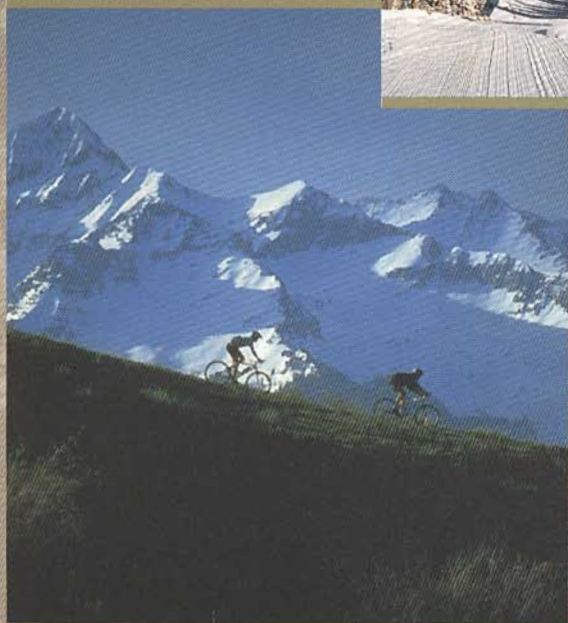

CARPE DIEM

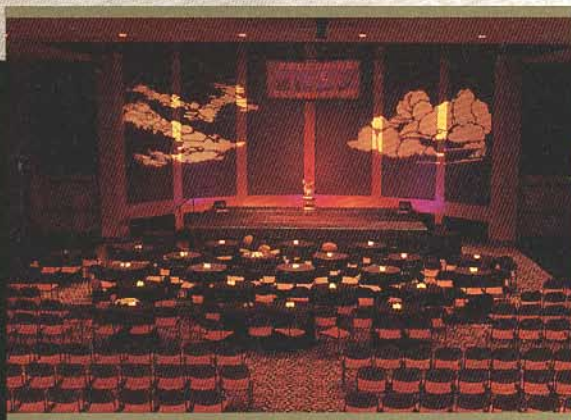
If the trail's the *thing*, Telluride's the *place*.

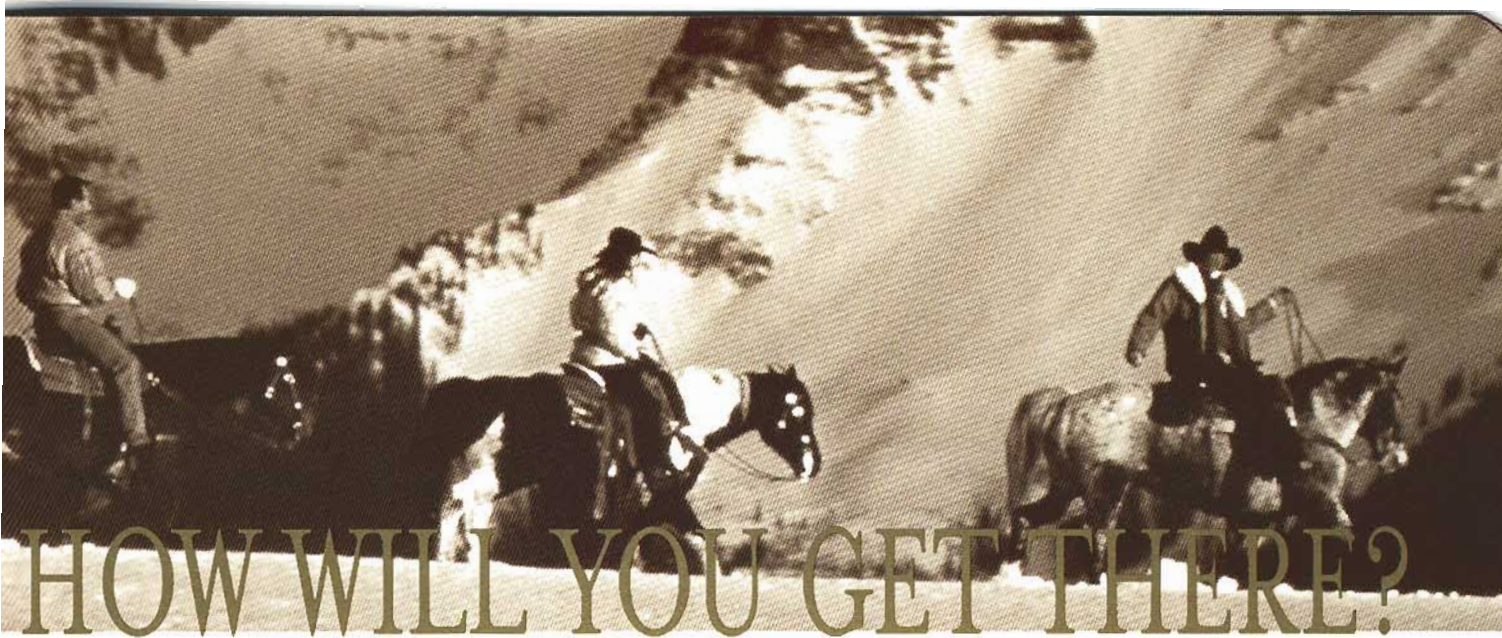

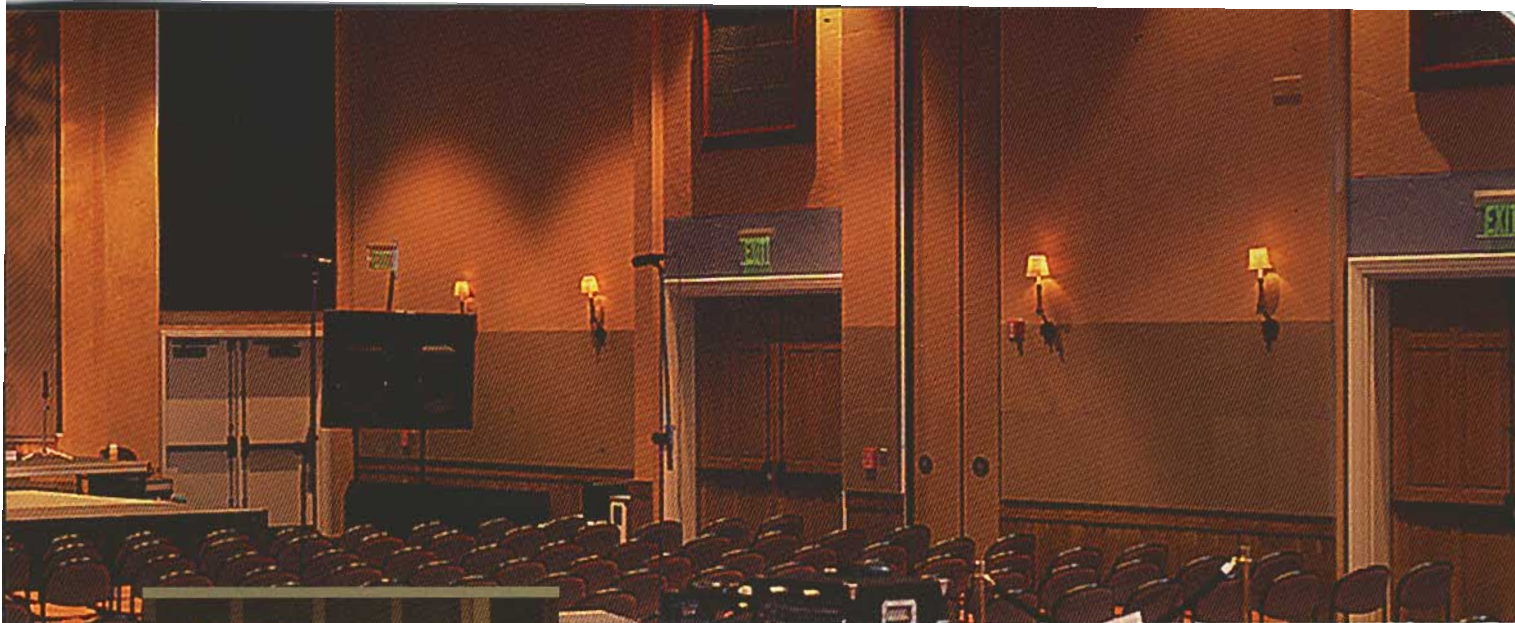

CONTINUING EDUCATION

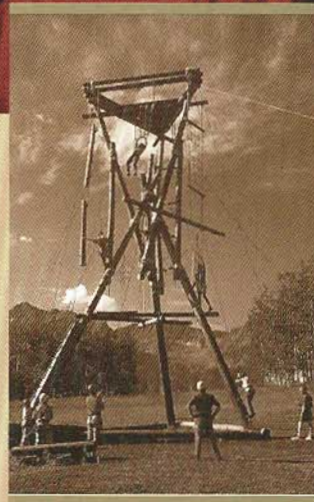

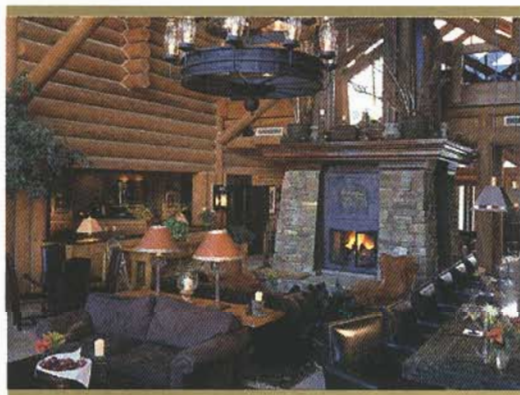
